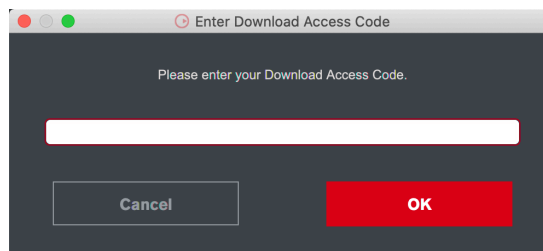
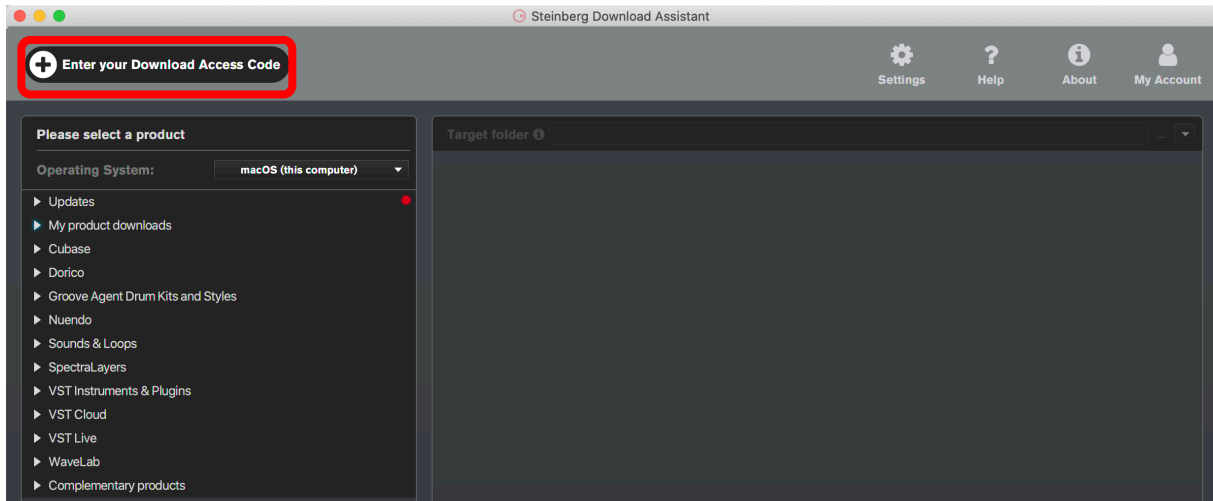


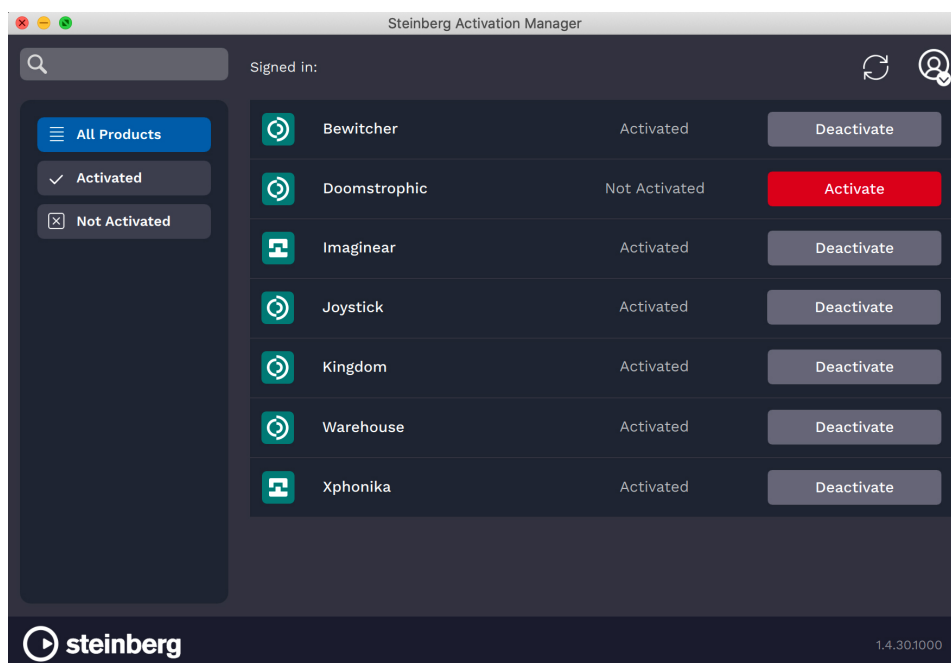
“Doomstrophic” Activation and Installation

1. Activate your copy of Doomstrophic via Steinberg Download Assistant and Activation Manager
(Note: If you are using the Steinberg eLicenser System via a hardware key or dongle, please refer to this website <https://helpcenter.steinberg.de/hc/en-us/articles/360017146019> and this video <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ftp6M5jVf0U>.)

- a. Open the latest version of Steinberg Download Assistant and enter Download Access Code

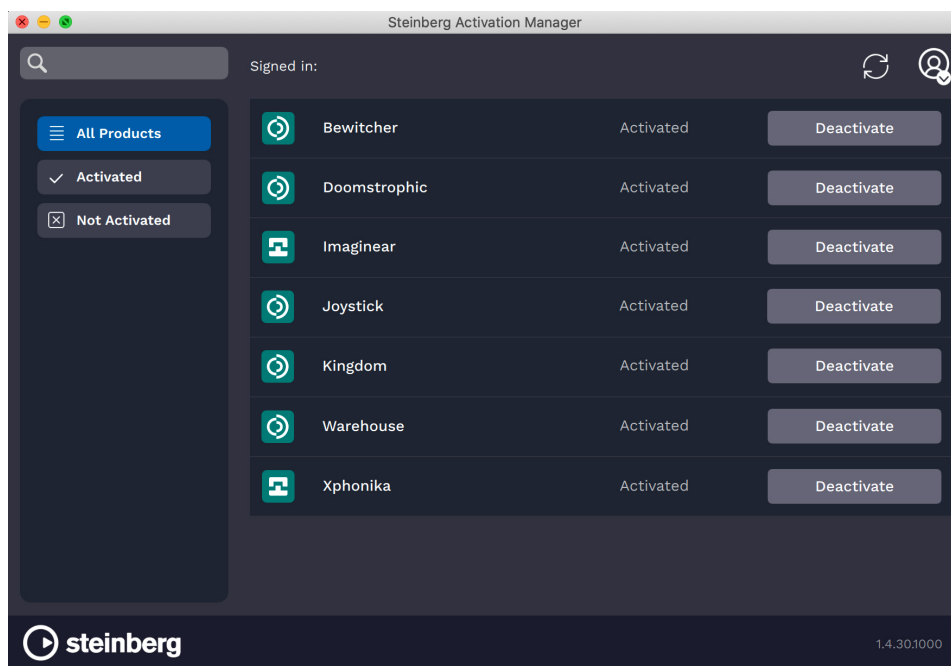


- b. To activate your copy of Doomstrophic, open the latest version of Steinberg Activation Manager where Doomstrophic is now included under “All Products”



c. Click “Activate”

- This process is required when you try to use your copy in another computer.

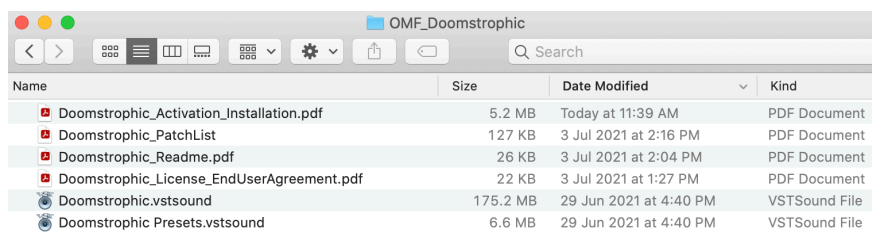


2. Download and unzip the file “OMF_Doomstrophic.zip”

3. Save all the contents of the folder “OMF_Doomstrophic” in your computer, Mac or Windows

- VST Presets (filename: Doomstrophic Presets.vstsound)
- Samples (filename: Doomstrophic.vstsound)
- Activation and Installation (filename: Doomstrophic_Activation_Installation.pdf)
- License Agreement (filename: Doomstrophic_License_EndUserAgreement.pdf)
- Patch List (filename: Doomstrophic_PatchList.pdf)
- Readme (filename: Doomstrophic_Readme.pdf)

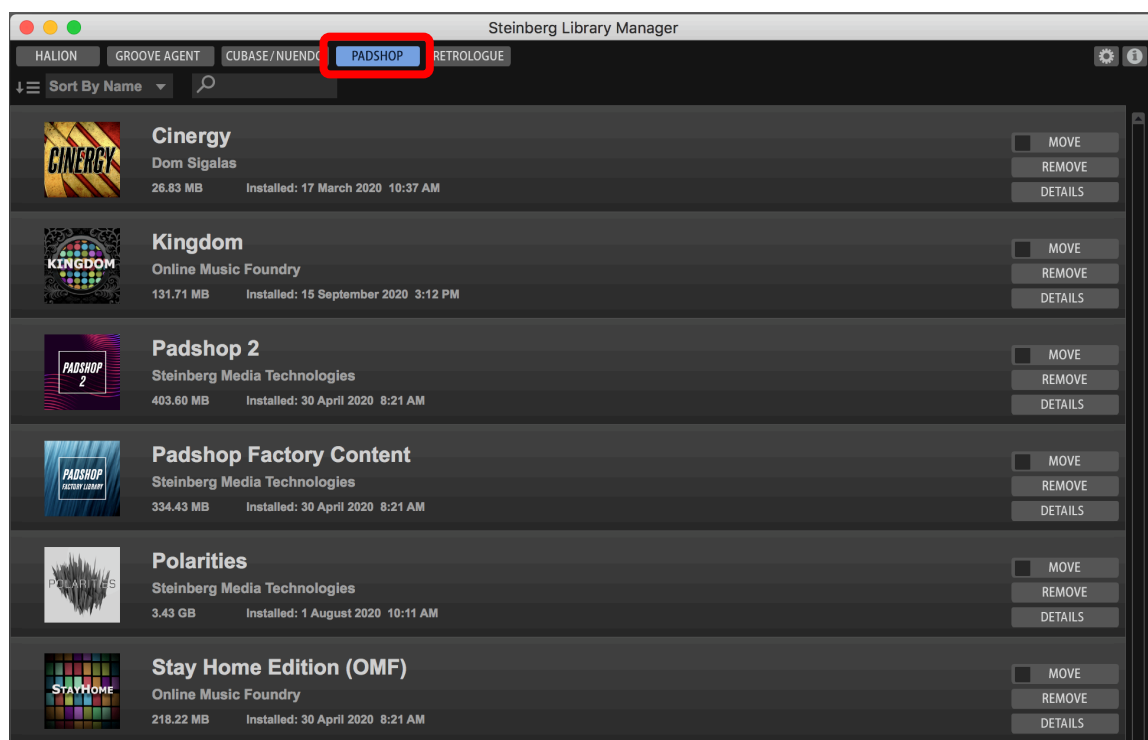
(IMPORTANT) DO NOT CHANGE the filenames of the presets and samples, “Doomstrophic Presets.vstsound” and “Doomstrophic.vstsound”



4. Install your copy of Doomstrophic

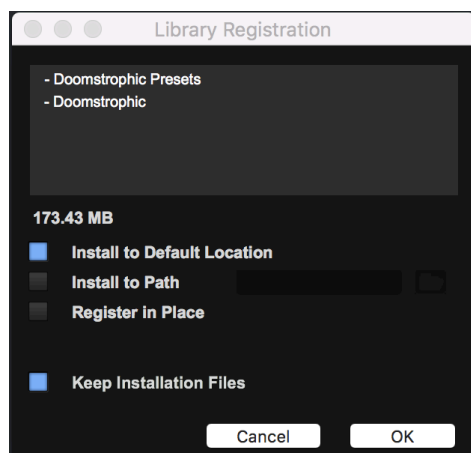
- Open the latest version of Steinberg Library Manager
- Select the “Padshop” tab

- c. All the libraries that are installed in your computer will show up.

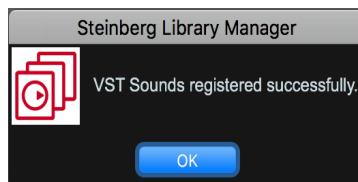


- d. Locate the folder "OMF_Doomstrophic" and double click the file "Doomstrophic Presets.vstsound" to install the presets

- Click "OK" to proceed with the Library Registration

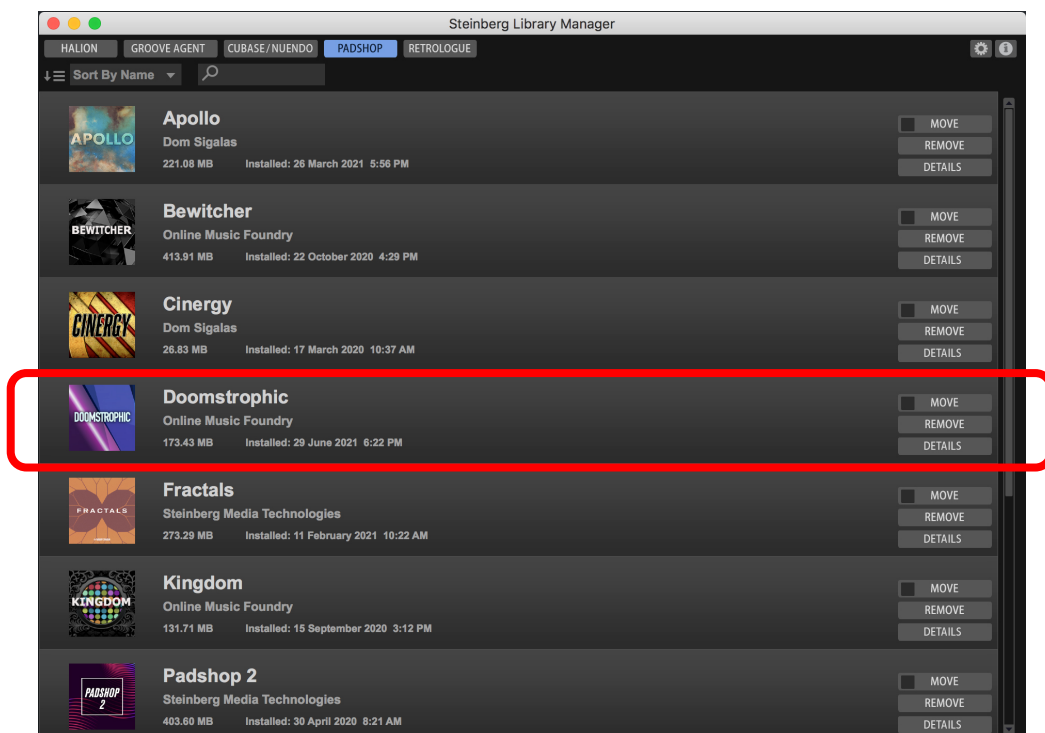


- Click "OK" when the registration is completed

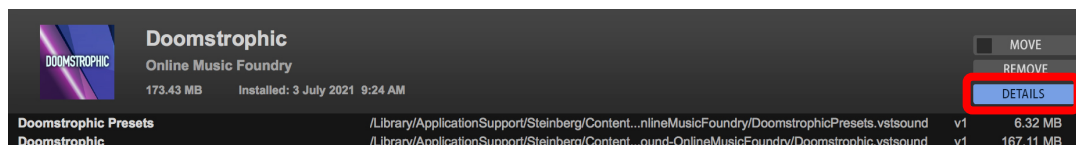


- e. Locate the folder "OMF_Doomstrophic" and double click the file "Doomstrophic.vstsound" to install the samples

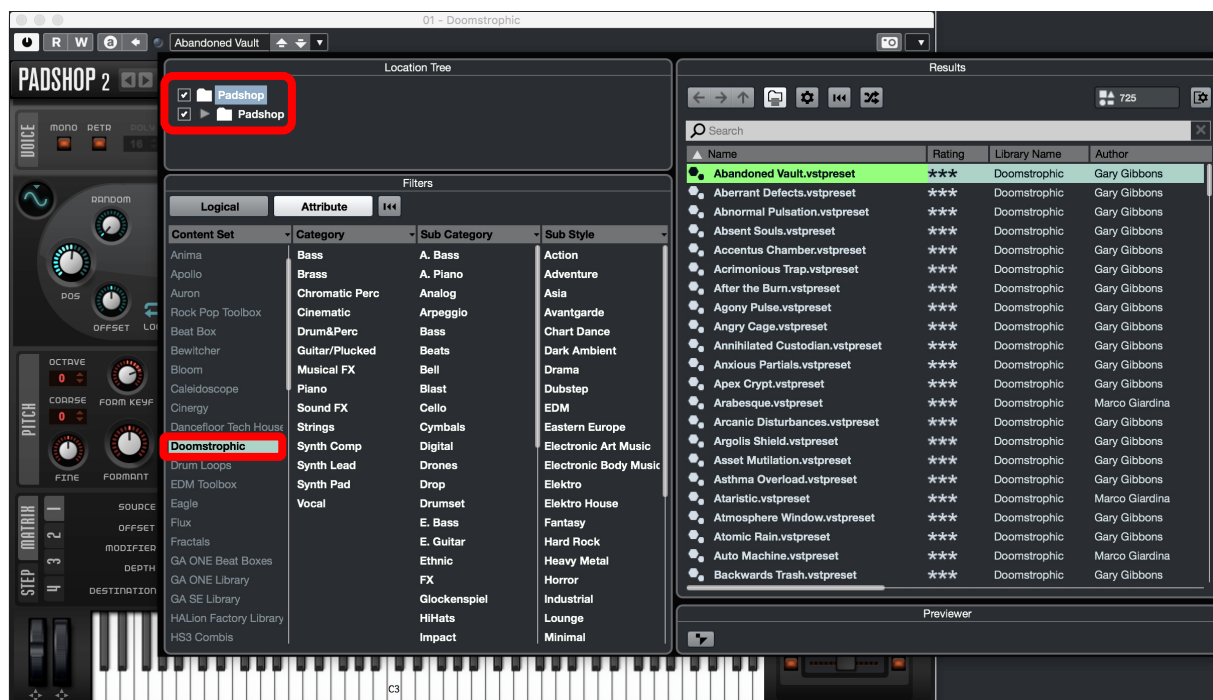
- f. Doomstrophic expansion pack is now included in Steinberg Library Manager



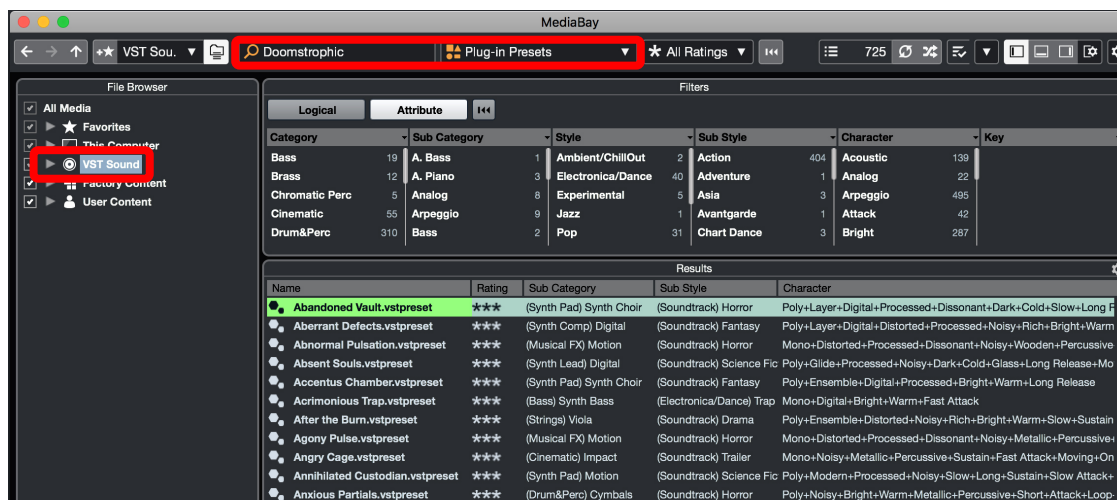
- g. To check where both files have been installed in your computer, select “Doomstrophic” and click “Details”



5. Turn on the DAW, load Padshop 2 and search for “Doomstrophic”



6. For Cubase users, “Doomstrophic” can also be located from the media bay.
 - a. Select VST Sound in the file browser
 - b. In the search window, type “Doomstrophic”



7. If Doomstrophic is not listed in Point 5 and Point 6 above, please reboot your computer and try again.
