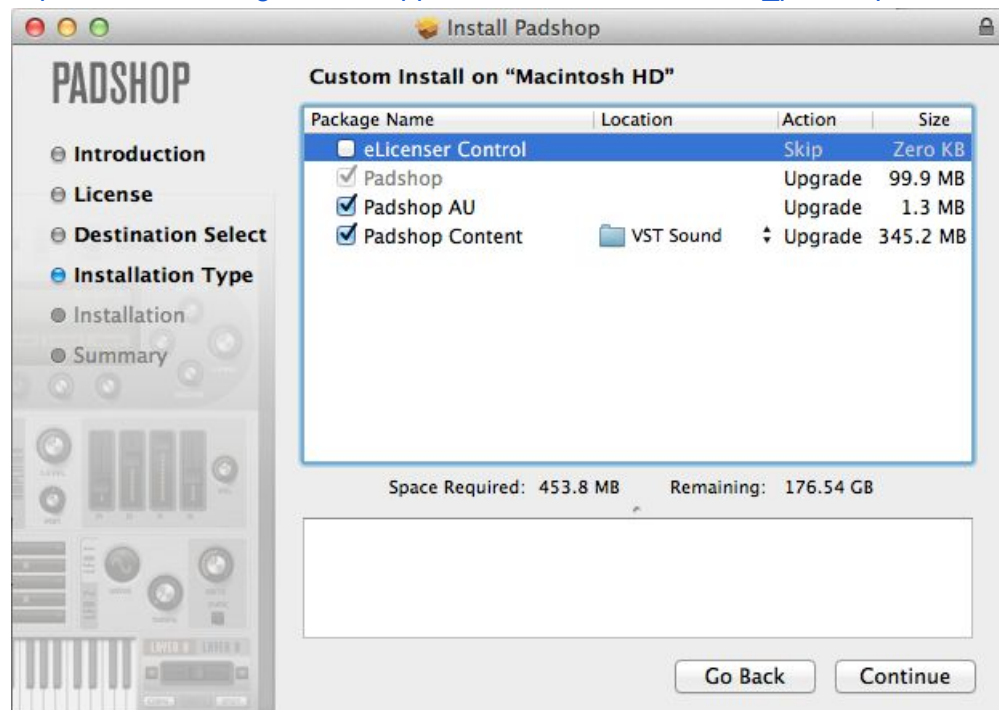
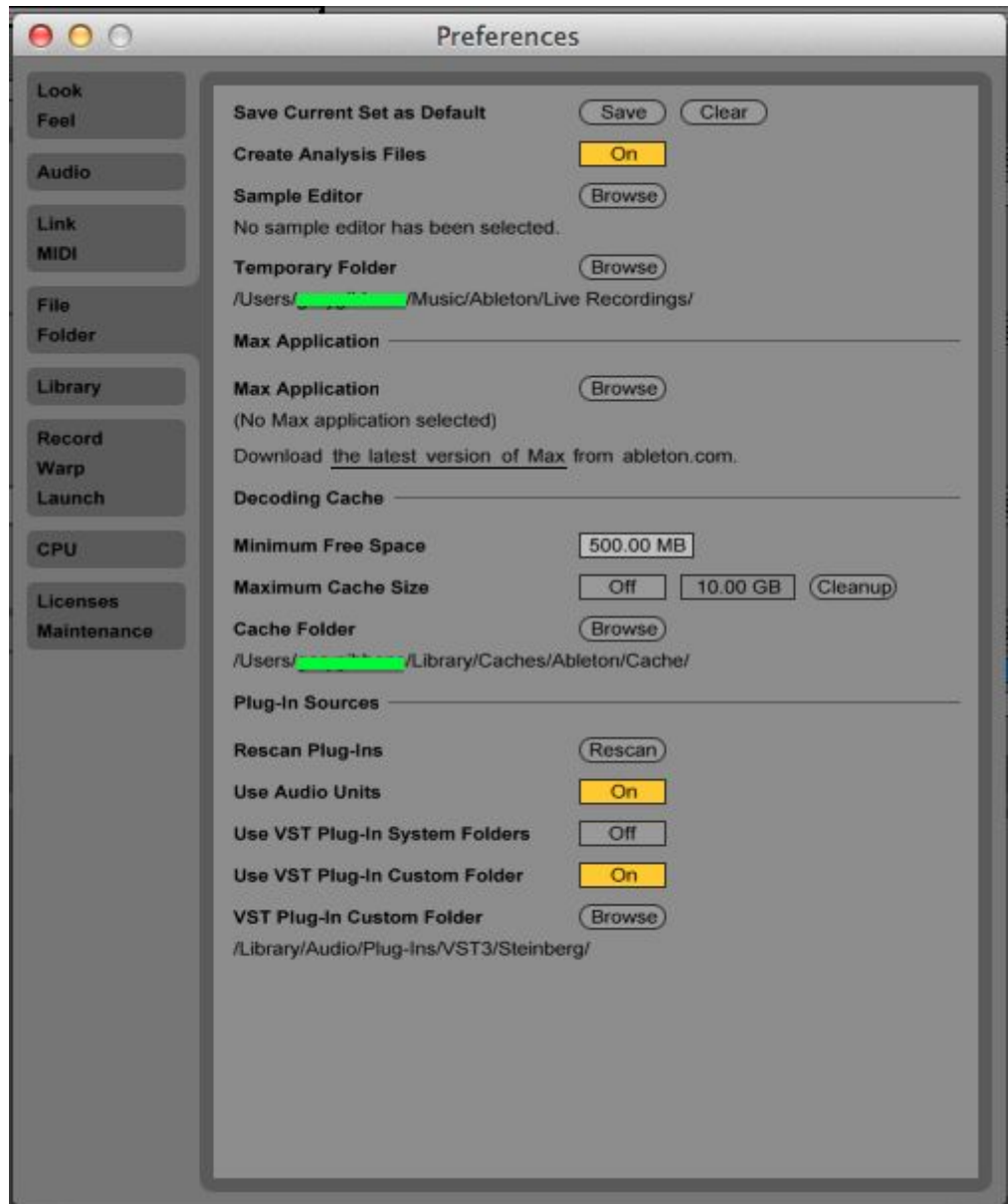


“Granular Frame Drums” Installation Test Log ***with Ableton Live 9.6***

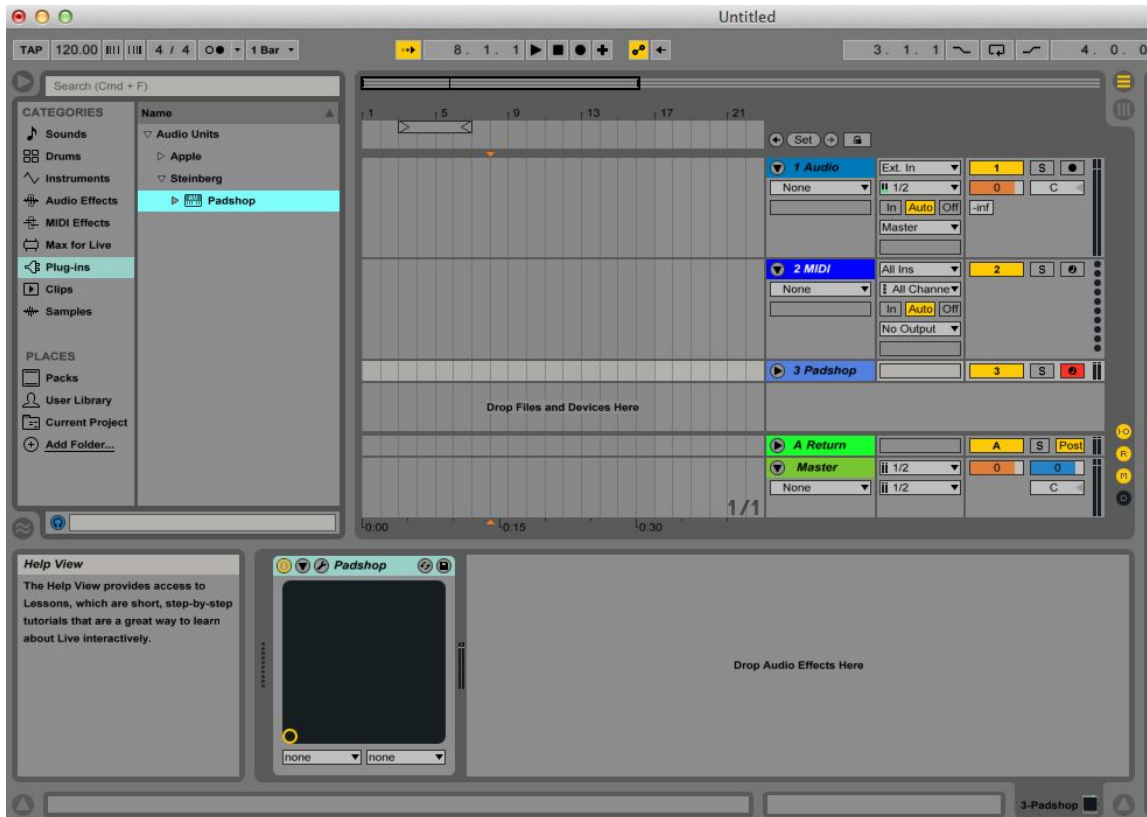
1. System used:
 - a. Mac OS X Version 10.7.5
 - b. Processor 2.4 GHz Intel Core i5
 - c. Memory 8GB 1600 MHz DDR3
2. “Granular Frame Drums” VST presets & samples installed in the right folders before this installation test
 - a. Procedures as stated in the “GranularFrameDrums_Installation.pdf”
3. Downloaded & installed softwares:
 - a. Ableton Live 9 for Mac OS X 64-bit (Version 9.6) - from <https://www.ableton.com/en/shop/>
 - b. Padshop for Mac OS X 10.6, 10.7, 10.8, 10.9 (including Padshop AU & Padshop Content) - from http://www.steinberg.net/en/support/downloads/downloads_padshop.html



4. Customized the Ableton Live Preferences (Preferences > File Holder > Plug-In Sources)
 - a. Turned on “Use Audio Units” and “Use VST Plug-In Custom Folder”
 - b. Selected /Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/VST3/Steinberg/ as “VST Plug-In Custom Folder”
 - c. Clicked “Rescan” once



5. Found "Padshop" under Plug-Ins > Audio Units > Steinberg >



6. Opened Padshop GUI



7. Found "Granular Frame Drums" VST presets - GFD



8. Loaded one of the presets successfully



9. Found "Granular Frame Drums" samples



10. Loaded one of the samples successfully
